

Bonny Baby

Designed by Wendy-Sue Wilkinson, this little youngster can be cradled in your arms



Lily Jean is a beautiful baby girl made from soft pink-tinted mohair.

She stands just 10cm (4") tall and if you look closely you will see that she is sucking her tiny thumb!

Lily is fully jointed and can be positioned sitting or standing. We think this tiny ted is absolutely adorable and are sure you'll want her to join your hug today!

You Will Need

- 1 piece of mohair (4mm pile or shorter) approximately 16 x 21cm
- A small piece of toning ultrasuede for pads
- 2 Onyx bead eyes
- 3 x 10mm cotter pin joints (head and legs)
- 2 x 8mm cotter pin joints
- Matching thread to sew
- No 12 pearl cotton in black and pink for features
- Stuffing
- Sewing needles
- Embroidery scissors
- Fine nosed pliers
- Manicure stick for stuffing and turning
- Fine knitting needle for making holes
- Tracing or greaseproof paper
- Thin card to transfer pattern
- Fabric pens or crayons (optional)
- Ribbon and buttons to trim

Hints and Tips

- Read through all the instructions before you start. Cut out the pattern on the lines. When stitching them with right sides together, sew about 2mm from the edge throughout.
- Use double thread for extra strength
- If your fabric begins to fray, over sew the edges of the seams or use an anti-fraying liquid but beware, this makes pen lines bleed onto the fabric.
- Use a fine running stitch to tack pieces together before back-stitching all the seams. This makes it easier to make minor adjustments. Keep your stitches as small and even as you can.

Step by Step
